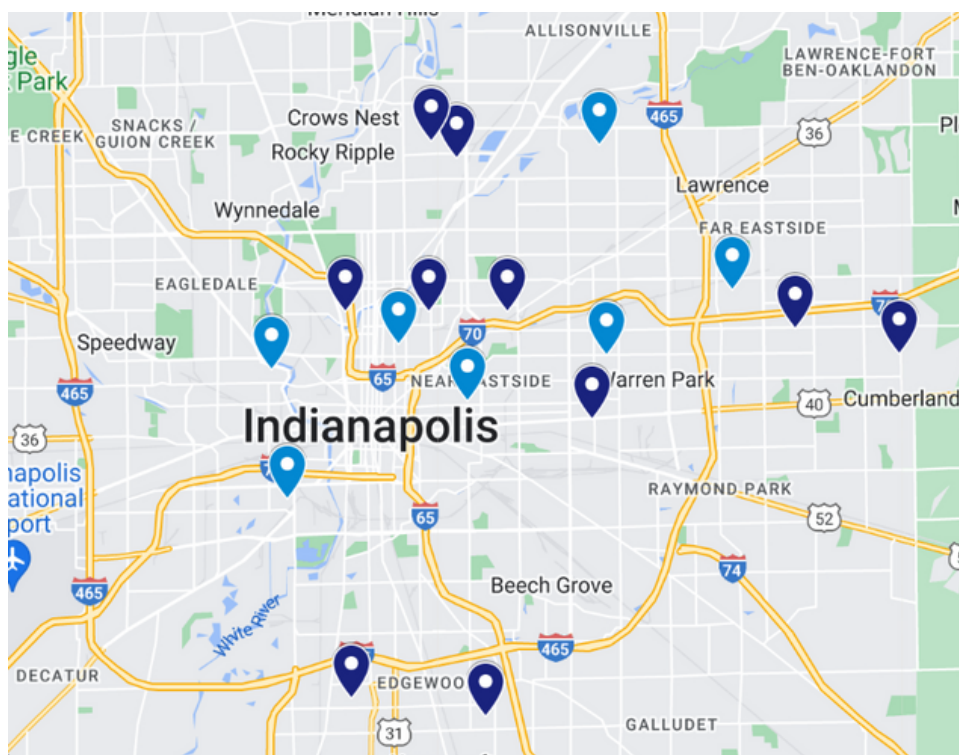

Playworks in partnership with local elementary schools in Marion County, offers full and part time services focused on recess implementation or consultancy: Coach & TeamUp.

Through these services, a Playworker ensures that four key components are implemented: a high-functioning recess, Junior Coach Leadership Program, instructional class game time with each class in the school, and developmental sports leagues.
