CORPORATE PLAY DAY

THE POWER OF PLAY IS NOT ONLY FOR KIDS, IT'S A TRANSFORMATIVE SOURCE OF STRESS RELIEF AND RELATIONSHIP BUILDING FOR ADULTS

Facilitated by Playworks trainers and coaches, your employees will engage in lively games that foster collaboration, teamwork, and flexible conflict resolution - skills as vital for children at school as they are for adults at work.

After learning some of Playworks' signature games, attention getters, and conflict resolution strategies, employees fan out on the playground of one or more Playworks partner schools and assist the Playworks Coach in facilitating recess games with kids. Employees will experience firsthand the transformative power of play - both for themeselves and the kids they meet.



STRUCTURE

We recommend a minimum of 5 employees, and can usually accommodate up to 30 volunteers at a single school location. Larger groups are usually divided to multiple school locations, and can be trained together before moving to separate schools then reunited for a group debrief.

Depending on your needs and capacity, the Play Day experience can be structured to run an efficient two hours up to a half-day immersion in play, teambuilding and volunteering.

PRICING

We customize each Play Day to best meet your needs, so the fee for engagement varies, generally from \$2,500 - \$6,000 per site, depending on the group size and duration of event. This fee is considered a partnership donation to Playworks, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization and is tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.
