



# North Carolina 2017 Annual Survey Results

from a Spring 2017 survey of school staff including administrators, teachers, and support staff at schools partnering with Playworks to achieve safe and healthy play



## School Climate and Partnership

**89%** of staff AGREE that Playworks improves overall **school climate**

**95%** of staff AGREE that Playworks creates a **safe and effective learning environment**

**98%** of staff want to **continue partnering** with Playworks



## Learning Through Play

**97%** of staff report an INCREASE in the number of students engaged in **healthy play** at recess

**13 =** Average number of **HOURS teachers recovered** transitioning students from recess to learning

## Youth Leadership

**83%** of staff report that **Junior Coaches** take on a leadership role during recess



## Outcomes In the Classroom

Percent of staff who report an INCREASE in:

Students' level of participation in academic activities **100%**

Level of cooperation among students during class **100%**

Students' ability to focus on class activities **95%**

Percent of staff who report a DECREASE in:

Playground conflicts spilling into the classroom **88%**

Amount of class time spent resolving conflicts **85%**

Number of disruptive events in the classroom **95%**



## Outcomes On the Playground

Percent of staff who report an INCREASE in:

Number of students who are physically active **100%**

Level of cooperation among students at recess **100%**

Students' use of conflict resolution strategies **97%**

Percent of staff who report a DECREASE in:

Number of bullying incidents **86%**

Number of conflicts (physical or verbal) **81%**

Number of disciplinary incidents **81%**

Total responses = 41
