

CIRCLE DODGEBALL

- 1. Players form a circle.
- 2. 1-3 students stand inside the circle (DODGERS).
- 3. The others stay on the outside (TOSSERS).
- 4. Dodgers on the inside of the circle move within the circle to avoid being hit by the balls being tossed.
- 5. Tossers on the outside of the circle UNDERHAND toss the balls, trying to hit the Dodgers from the <u>waist down.</u>
- 6. Tossers must stay outside of the circle in order to toss a ball.
- 7. If a Dodger is hit from the waist down, he/she must trade places with the Tosser who hit them with a ball.
- 8. Tosser and Dodger give a HIGH FIVE as they switch places.
