- **An experienced Playworks Site Coordinator is on-site for a five-day block each month to model and teach strategies, games, and systems to develop and sustain a positive educational culture for everyone, starting at recess.**
- **A Playworks Program Manager works directly with school administration to oversee and guide program implementation at each site.**
- **Playworks provides resources and tools for ongoing assessment, evaluation, and implementation.**

Your school community sustains a positive recess culture throughout the school year.

- **A designated Recess Manager and Recess Coach from your school leads the Junior Coach Leadership Program and ensures a high-functioning recess throughout the year.**
- **Your Recess Team (adults who support recess) receives in-depth professional development to create a positive recess climate.**
- **Junior Coaches (4th and 5th graders) build social and emotional skills through leadership training. They lead games, resolve conflicts, and serve as role models at recess.**
- **Administrators, teachers, parents, and volunteers build shared expectations for safe, healthy play and behavior at recess and beyond.**



How TeamUp Works

Staff Trainings: monthly trainings and coaching sessions are provided to the Recess Team to hone new skills for safe and healthy play.

Consultative Support: guided strategic sessions with the school's leadership and Recess Team to sustain recess culture, systems, and staff.

Junior Coach Program: learn how to influence a positive recess culture through student leaders.

Class Game Time: group lessons to teach students and teachers rules, expectations, and skills for positive recess culture.
